

LOCKOUT/TAGOUT (LOTO)

Lockout/Tagout Course Overview and Objectives:

In compliance with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) regulation 29 CFR 1910.147, this training shall be provided for all authorized and affected employees whenever there is a change in their job assignments, a change in machines, equipment or processes that present a new hazard, or when there is a change in the energy control procedures. Employees whose jobs require them to operate or use machinery or equipment that is being serviced or maintained or whose jobs require them to work in areas where service or maintenance is being performed should take this course. This training is tailored to your facility to meet your organization's specific needs.
